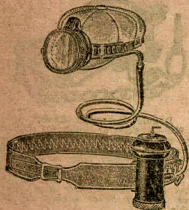

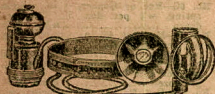

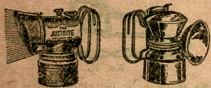
HUNTING LAMPS.



No. 90—Columbia, acetylene, brass, gun metal finish, w't of headlight 6 oz., diam. 2 1/4 in., ground imported double convex lens, rubber tubing, generator 3 1/2 in. long 2 in. in diam., carbide capacity for 5 1/2 hours, w't 16 oz., each .....DEJ \$7.50



No. 25G—Kruschke, acetylene, single lens, 6x2 1/2 in. generator, convex glass, 4 in. in diam., style 2 adjustable candle burner, hinged front door to shut off light, 3 ft. of 3/4 in. rubber tubing, leather head strap, w't complete 2 lbs., .....each DEJ \$8.00  
 No. 25D—Acetylene, double lens, with heavy magnifying 2 1/2 in. bull's eye lens; otherwise same as No. 25G, each .....BAJ \$8.50

No. 100DG. No. 290DG.

No. 100DG—Justite, nickel plated brass, height 3 1/4 in., 2 in. German silver reflector, with hood, improved soot-proof burner tip, cap hook and handles, complete with one extra carbide container and directions, w't each 10 oz. ...per dozen ADDJ \$34.00  
*Burns four hours to one filling.*  
 No. 290DG—Baldwin, brass, nickel plated and highly polished, height 3 1/2 in., hinged handles, hook for cap or belt, concentrating reflector, with extra carbide container, w't each 6 oz. ....per dozen AFBJ \$7.00  
*One filling gives 14 candle power for three hours.*

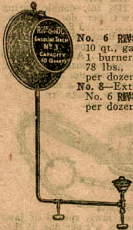
OUTDOOR TORCHES.



No. 0 REVEROC—Gasoline, 4 qt., japanned tank, 1 burner, w't per doz. 35 lbs., .....per dozen ABJJ \$20.00  
 No. 2 REVEROC—Gasoline, 4 qt., japanned tank, 2 burners, w't per doz. 60 lbs., .....per dozen BAFJ \$36.00  
 No. 7—Extra burners, for REVEROC torches, Nos. 0 and 2, per dozen J1FJ \$16.00

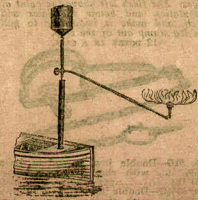
Pipe runs through the tank and is securely fastened on top to the hinge. In use the entire torch is supported by hinge and pipe, with no strain on tank. Made for rough usage. Strong winds will not extinguish the flame.

 No. 8—Extra burners, for No. 6 REVEROC, per dozen ADDJ \$24.00

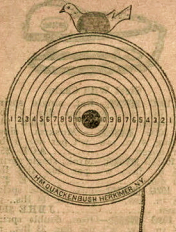

Produces a powerful and steady flame. SIX TORCHES IN A CASE.

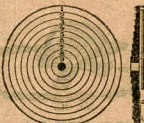


No. 1G—Baker, gasoline, 5 qt., japanned tank, 1 burner, w't per doz. 72 lbs., .....per dozen BHHJ \$48.00  
 No. 9—Extra burners, for No. 1G torch, per dozen .....AJHJ \$18.00

GALLERY TARGETS.



No. 3—Round, diam. 12 in., 1/4 in. thick, with bell and image, made of a grade of metal particularly adapted to stand cartridges, with 3 1/2 in. diam. bull's eyes, w't 12 lbs., .....each CJJ \$5.00  
 When bull's-eye is hit, a bird rises and the bell, similar in sound to an electric bell, rings a few seconds.  
 \* While designed for the use of 22 caliber cartridges, the spring may be quickly adjusted for service as an air rifle target.  
 We can furnish No. 3 Targets with 3/4 in., 5/8 in. and 1 in. bull's eye at same price for shipment from factory.



No. 19A—Plain round, 1/2 in. iron, diam. 12 in., 1/4, 1/2 and 3/4 in. open bull's eye, for BB caps, ringing gong when bull's eye is hit, self-setting, w't 13 1/2 lbs., each .....AJJ \$2.50  
 No. 19—Same as No. 19A, 3/4 in. iron, with 1/4, 1/2, 3/4 and 1 in. open bull's eye, for 22 caliber cartridges, w't 20 lbs., .....each BAJ \$3.50  
 The construction of the target's surface brings out each numbered circle clearly, thus aiding the marksman in locating his shot.



No. 0116—Entirely of heavy iron, for 22 caliber cartridge, birds and stars falling back when hit, 6 objects to shoot at, made for outdoor shooting, reset by rope from stand, w't 13 1/4 lbs., .....each AJJ \$3.00  
 No. 0118—Same as No. 0116 but larger, with 8 objects to shoot at, w't 23 lbs., each .....B DJ \$4.00  
 These targets are substantially made and will stand extreme wear and tear. The heavy metal objects have their weights so evenly distributed that the entire target is reset with a slight tug at the rope.
