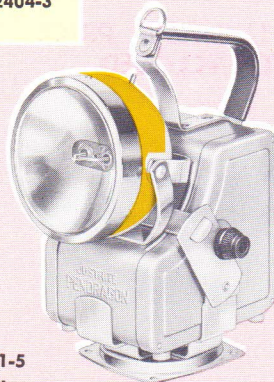

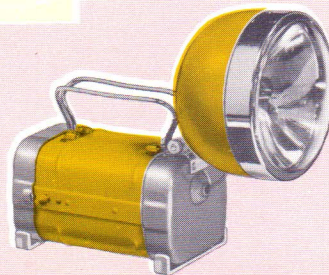
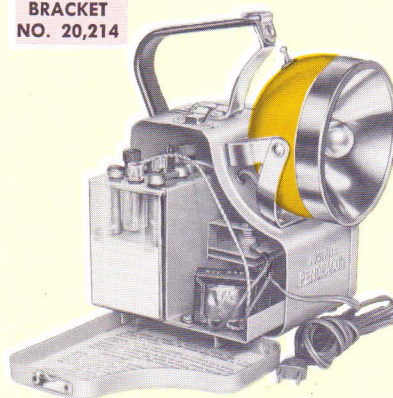

JUSTRITE "PENDRAGON"® LANTERNS ENTIRELY NEW, ENTIRELY DIFFERENT

An entirely new Portable Searchlight for industrial use. Smaller than other searchlights of equal power. Made of heavy gauge steel coated to resist rust and painted with "lamp silver" catalyst enamel. **Battery Case designed to hold three Lantern Batteries.** Handle is mounted so searchlight carries easily regardless of the number of batteries in case. Large headpiece is mounted in Double Bracket on battery case to turn up or down. A Toggle Switch is conveniently located on the headpiece. Headpiece will take either a Sealed Beam Lamp or a 4½" Reflector.

With 4½" precision designed vacuum metalized Reflector adjustable sockets can be furnished to hold a miniature screw or bayonet base lamp, or a candelabra screw or bayonet base lamp.

For ordinary use, use Three 6 volt Lantern (dry) Batteries making contact on the 6 volt, parallel wired, Contact Insulator Plate. Two batteries can be used but will not last proportionately as long. One battery can be used but will last a short time only if drain is over .5 amp.

For 12 volt circuit, Contact Insulator Plate can be furnished which has series wired contacts (on the back of the plate wired for 6 volts), and uses Two Lantern Batteries. A third battery can be carried as a spare or placed in the circuit to produce 18 volts, for special applications.

PENDRAGON STORAGE

BATTERY LANTERN

The Pendragon equipped with a storage battery and charger makes an ideal lantern. Not only is it cheaper to operate than the lantern equipped with dry cells but it gives more light. The battery can be recharged without removing it from the lantern by plugging cord attached to charger into any 110-120 volt "A-C" outlet.

"YELLOW-FLASH" V-12 SEARCHLIGHT

The newest and most useful light made. Case designed to use 8 flashlight batteries arranged to give 12 volts, or to use one 6 volt lantern battery. Reflector designed to use a miniature screw base or Prefocused lamp.

For an intensely white powerful beam use 8 flashlight batteries to produce 12 volts and Tubular Lamp No. 965 which gives 6.3 spherical candlepower; more than 2½ times as much as any lamp suitable for use with one lantern battery.

For a brilliant long range spot beam, use reflector with a holder with a coiled spring, and use Prefocused Lamp No. PR 13 or PR 17 with one 6 volt lantern battery.

For regular hand lantern beam with one 6 volt lantern battery use reflector with holder containing min. sc. base socket. Use miniature screw base Lamp Bulb No. 27 for general use; No. 425 for brighter light but less battery life; No. 502 used by the railroads for long battery life.

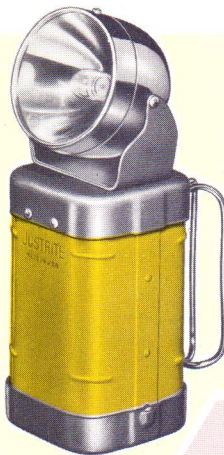

Instead of the folding handles on the No. 2209, the No. 2305 has a finger ring type handle 2½" wide, which folds down against back of case, making the light easy to pack as well as easy to use.

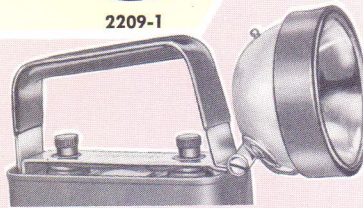
SETS OF TWO LIGHTS
ONE RED AND ONE WHITE

For highway protection and to work efficiently, two lights are absolutely necessary; one to give a powerful white light and one to give a flashing red light. The white light is used to light up immediate surroundings, identify objects in the distance and in case of trouble to give light to find the causes and to make repairs. The red light is placed to mark obstructions and give warning to approaching traffic. On vacation and in camp the red light should be used to mark danger points. WHY YOU SHOULD USE A SAFETY CAN

The only cans safe to use for flammable or highly volatile liquids are those which are labeled by, or have stamped on them the insignia of, the organization which tested and approved them. Cans designed for safety will not tip over if placed on an incline of thirty degrees; if placed on their side they will not leak more than four drops a minute; if thrown in a fire they will not explode, the liquid will be safely contained until completely vaporized.

There is a difference between many so-called safety cans, and cans designed for safety that have been tested and approved by an authorized organization. Get a genuine safety can and avoid a possible catastrophe. Type I is the conventional design with short valved spout used to both pour and fill. Type II pours through a flexible tubular nozzle attached to a valved spout and is known as a "filling can".

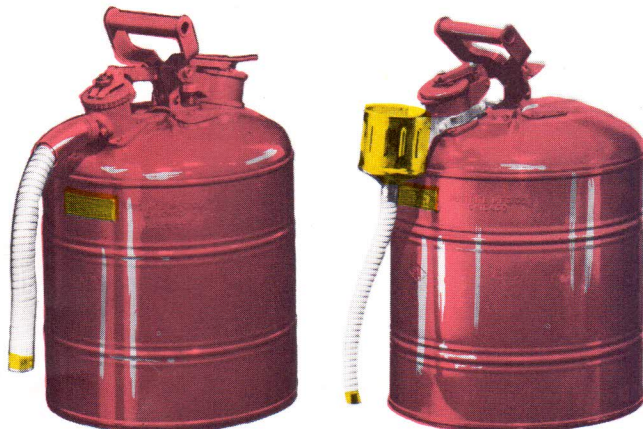
